# Bona Wood Floor Polish (Gloss)

For lacquered wood floors

Wood floor polish to extend the life of your floor's finish and protect against wear

#### **PREPARATION**

Remove loose dirt and grit from your floor. Clean floor thoroughly with Bona Wood Floor Cleaner or Bona OxyPower Wood Floor Deep Cleaner (sold only in selected markets) and let dry. It is important that the floor is thoroughly clean as otherwise the dirt will be sealed onto the floor by the coat of polish and an uneven, unsightly appearance will result.

**IMPORTANT!** Do not use on any floor that has been waxed or oiled, wax and oil residues will prevent proper adhesion of Bona Wood Floor Polish to the floor. If uncertain, perform a small test before use to ensure desired result.

Shake bottle thoroughly before use and apply at normal room temperature, 18-25°C.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

- 1. Pour a wide, line of Bona Wood Floor Polish on a small section of the floor.
- 2. Immediately spread the product over the section using a Bona Microfiber Applicator Pad.
- 3. Complete section by smoothing with the applicator pad in the direction of the wood.
- 4. Continue section by section until the entire floor has been treated.
- 5. Rinse and wash applicator pad with detergent and warm water after use.

The floor can be walked on after 2 hours but avoid heavy traffic and replacement of furniture and rugs until after the first 12 hours.

### **MAINTENANCE**

Regularly clean your floors with Bona Wood Floor Cleaner and a Bona Microfiber Cleaning Pad. When the floor is starting to show signs of wear and needs freshening up, clean and apply a new layer of Bona Wood Floor Polish. For periodic removal of polish build up use Bona Polish Remover.
